

Hiring Foreign "Specialty Occupation" Workers? Deadline is April 1

H-1B Visa season is here and the deadline for filing is April 1, 2019. H-1B visas are available for companies that need to fill "specialty occupation" positions.

What is a "specialty occupation" position?

"Specialty Occupation" is defined by U.S. regulation as an employment position that requires:

- (a) theoretical and practical application of a body of highly specialized knowledge, and
- (b) attainment of a bachelor's or higher degree in the specific specialty (or its equivalent) as a minimum for entry into the occupation in the United States." INA § 214(i)(1).

Typical industries employing "specialty occupation" workers include IT, education, medicine, engineering, telecommunications and financial. With USCIS proposed changes to the H-1B visa program, it's important to work with an immigration attorney that will help your company navigate critical timing, regulations and processes.
